- Diagrams have been adjusted to remove dark corridor to west of Otterpool Manor at this location:

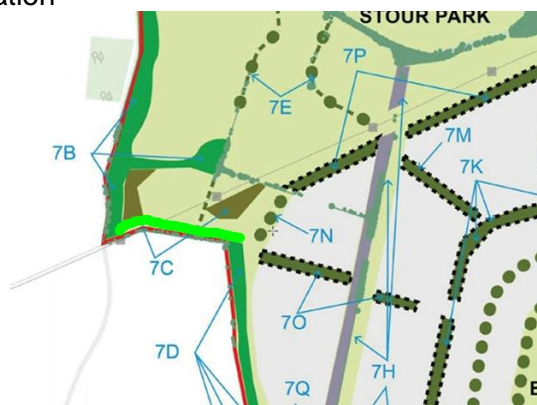

- **Dog walking**
 - P85 Open Space Typologies - Text amended to remove reference to SANG and additional page with information on dog walking added – see Appendix 6.7 Recreational Space and Dog Walking – outlines areas provided for walking dogs including:
 - Recreational areas
 - off lead areas (mainly in the 3 destination parks) and
 - sensitive areas where dogs should be walked on paths and on lead only

- **Additional information on management of SSSI**
 - P92 – 93 Notes related to Otterpool Quarry SSSI has been updated- covers broad aim of management plan, non-permitted practices and activities and management principles

- **Green Infrastructure Principles**
 - P11 Principle 4 - Altered to include reference to providing sufficient green open space to avoid impact of development on AONB

- **AONB leading design of Green Infrastructure**
 - P6 Key messages from other strategies - Additional bullet point added to reference influence of AONB on masterplan design and of policy guidance shaping amount of open space provided and mitigating pressure on surrounding amenity areas.
