Subject: Princes Parade Stopping Up Order

Dear Secretary of State

I object to the stopping up of Princes Parade for the following reasons:

- 1) It will take away my right to drive the entire length of the seafront from the BP garage to the Imperial Hotel. This coastal road provides a lovely view of the sea which gives me great pleasure.
- 2) There is no overriding need to move the road as the proposed buildings can be served from the existing road.
- 3) In the event that Princes Parade is stopped up, the flow of traffic on Seabrook Road will increase. I live on [REDACTED] and at present there are already times when I struggle to pull out of my drive due to the volume of traffic. I predict that this situation will worsen with the stopping up of Princes Parade. It should be taken into account that traffic levels on Seabrook Road are already set to increase with the proposed developments at St Saviour's Hospital and Cautley House.
