I am writing with regarding to the proposed closure of the coastal road running along Princes Parade and state my objections below:

1) The already congested A259 would become a gridlock if the above road was closed to through traffic. I can give an example, a few days ago I was driving towards Hythe from Sandgate and there was a long queue for petrol at the BP Garage and traffic was being diverted along the Princes Parade road. If this road had been closed there would have been traffic queues going back towards Folkestone and nobody would be going anywhere!

2) The A259 is already a very busy road and I fear that if Princes Parade was closed to through traffic this situation will only get worse with more houses being built in the area which will produce yet more cars, more congestion and more pollution in the environment.

Surely, this is not what our local council wants with people not being able to go about their day to day business with everything coming to a standstill and polluting the atmosphere.
