I would like to submit my objection to the re-routing of Prince's Parade.

At a time when we are facing global climate catastrophe and where architectural associations are clamouring for the government to introduce a policy of renovation rather than new build, it seems absurd that the local authority here are planning to build a new road.

The plans for the new road will destroy natural habitat and canal defences. It will have a hugely negative impact on people's access to the coast line as the old road that allows for people to drop off elderly and to engage with the outdoors will be hidden by the new (hyper-expensive) sea front houses.

The canal and Prince's Parade itself is a unique sanctuary for the people of Hythe and Folkestone.

I would like to strongly object to the council's plans for re-routing and redevelopment.
