My husband and I very strongly object to the stopping up of the road.

Currently there is a long stretch of road for people to park on, in particular it is of benefit to the elderly and those with disability to be able to access or just sit, so close to the beach. Reducing over 60 parking spaces will have a huge impact on some of the most vulnerable in our community.

Obviously the stopping up of the road would have huge implications for the habitat of a number of species which is so sad. We have 'Bee Kind' currently operating in this area and we hope this can be extended to include this road by keeping it.

On safety grounds it appears that the proposed road contravenes recommendations of the environment agencies with regard to waterways and lies within the 16m buffer zone from a main river. Should these things be ignored just for convenience when it suits?

We sincerely hope that the Public Enquiry finds in favour of NOT proceeding with the stopping up of Princes Parade.
