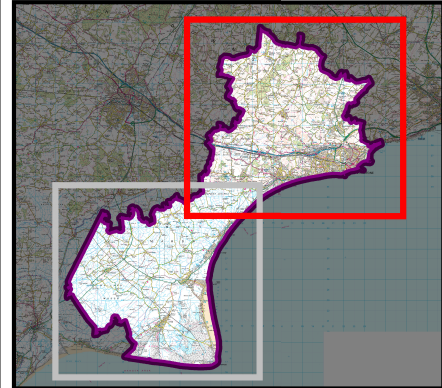


It should be noted that certain locations not shown may be at risk of flooding from other sources (piped drain systems, water mains etc) and from other watercourses not shown in this study.

The historical flood envelopes shown are based on a combination of Environment Agency data from remote sensing, ground surveys, staff observations, validated third party data and anecdotal evidence. There may be records of relatively minor flood events and the area at risk may be more extensive. These records should not be considered exhaustive and are known, in part, to be incomplete. An area without a flood outline does not necessarily imply no flood risk. The Environment Agency should be consulted with queries in any case.

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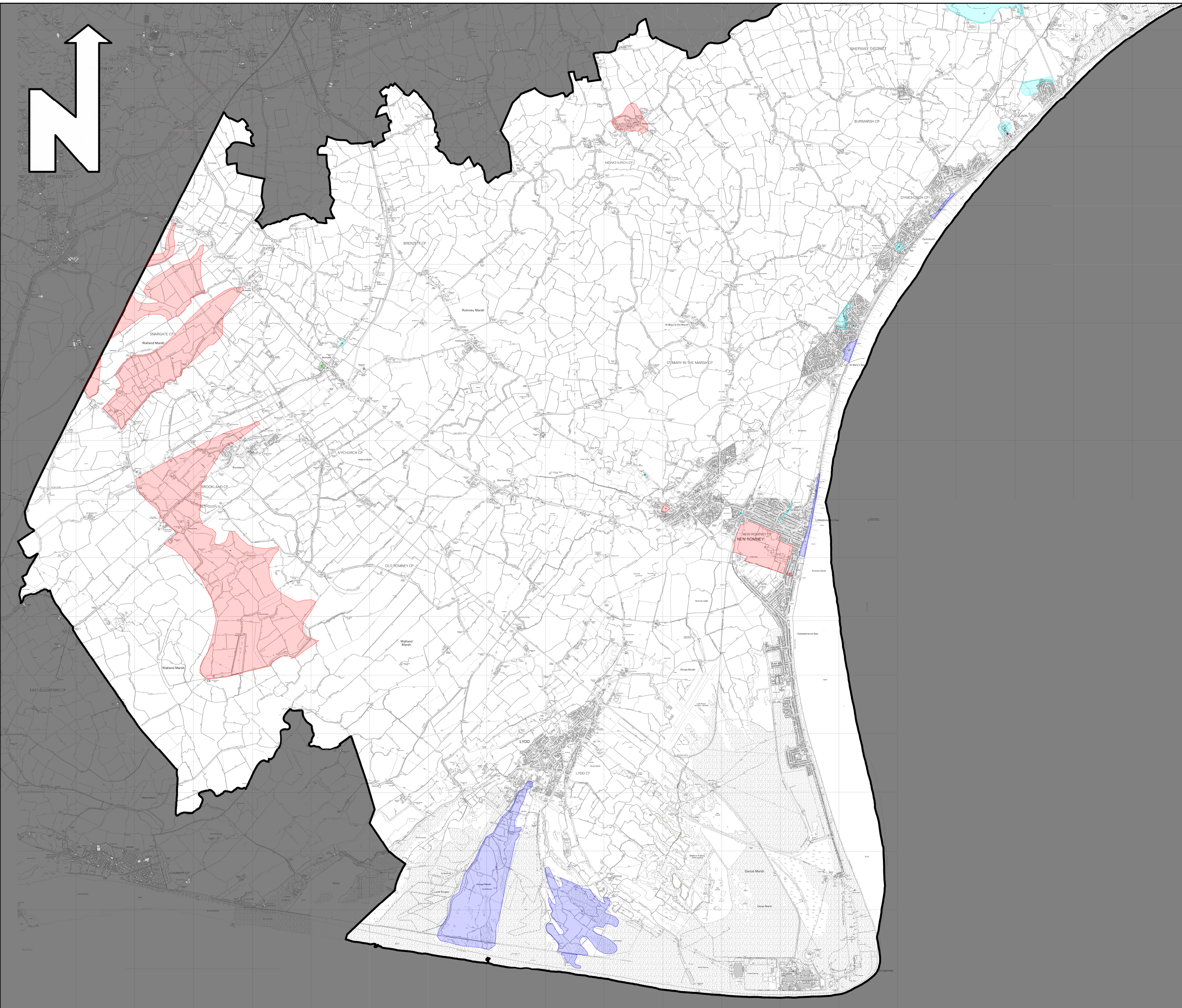

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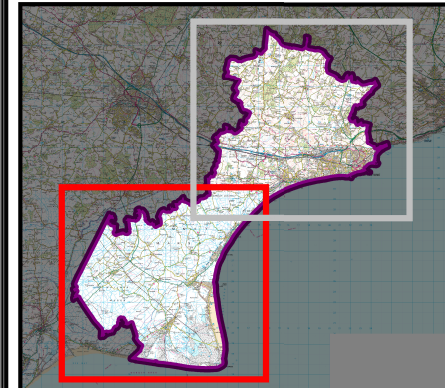


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Historic Flooding Maps
