### **Statement of Reasons**

### **Various Roads in Folkestone**

This Traffic Order proposes to extend the set of parking controls within the Folkestone Central ward.

The proposed extension will include the following streets:

Bluebell Gardens
Bouverie Road West (between Turketel Road and Grimston Avenue)
Earls Avenue
Godwyn Gardens
Godwyn Road
Grimston Avenue
Grimston Gardens
Jointon Road
Snowdrop Walk (Shorncliffe Road)

The proposals will help address the concerns of local people, and should reduce the incidence of commuter/long-term parking, enabling residents to park closer to their homes along with making the junctions safer with yellow line 'corner protection' to prevent vehicles parking on the corners of junctions.

Parking places are proposed to be permit holders only every day between 8am and 8pm. Local people and businesses are eligible to buy permits.

In developing these proposals, the council has sought to meet its responsibilities under section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians), and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway.
