I would like to object to the stopping up order reference number NATTRAN/SE/S247/3254 Princess parade Hythe the reason for my objections are below.

1; There is no need to move (stop up) the road as the proposed development could be served perfectly well by the existing road in fact I believe the proposed development would be served better as the road is today without the loss of a significant and popular stretch of road where you can park and enjoy the vista or fishing from the beach or enjoying the street food available.

2. If the road was to be moved this would mean significant and unnecessary disruption to the royal military canteen and nearby school.

3. Finally I am very concerned about flooding of the proposed development. Due to the threat of rising sea levels in a stretch of coastline which historically has been subject to flooding. I believe that the current road layout will provide additional protection.
