With reference to the above order I object to the proposed stopping up of Princes Parade, Hythe for the following reasons:

- Moving the road adjacent to the Royal Military Canal will do untold damage to a national monument and disturb and possibly kill much of the wildlife which is present.
- The beautiful walk and drive along the sea front will be lost forever and is part of Hythe's heritage
- Many disabled and immobile people will no longer have access to the sea front as they will not be able to drive and park directly on the sea front
