In my opinion I feel that the new position of the relocated road will have a significant detrimental impact on the canal which is a scheduled monument. It will inevitably destroy the peace and tranquillity that exists at present. Princess Parade is an historic and iconic road which has been in existence for many years. It attracts many visitors for a variety of reasons on a regular basis.

I am also a little bewildered at the proposal as the proposed new development can be accessed from Princess Parade. Shepway Council has recently installed parking meters along this stretch of road at a cost, I believe, in the region of £35000.
